## Life-Enriching Services

Mary's Place at Mennonite Village a nonprofit, adult foster care home for men and women diagnosed with early stages of memory loss who need minimum assistance with activities of daily living (ADLs).

Most people diagnosed with early stages of Alzheimer's and related dementia would like to remain in their own homes as long as possible. However, sometimes it becomes too difficult to do the everyday tasks of life, even with the help of others. Mary's Place adult foster care offers the benefits of specialized care and services in a home setting.

Mary's Place is a Class II Foster Care Home designed and licensed specifically for this purpose. It's a spacious, five-bedroom home with two bathrooms, a whirlpool bath, a full kitchen, a large living and dining area, and an office for around-the-clock staff. It also has a beautifully landscaped yard with a covered patio, a barbecue grill, and raised beds for vegetable and flower gardening.



## A Culture of Care and Respect

Mary's Place is staffed with a specially trained resident manager and caregivers who share a knack for interacting with those with memory loss. An on-call registered nurse is also available to provide medical care.

Each resident will have a private bedroom and 24-hour access to common areas in which they can socialize and participate in housekeeping, cooking, baking, and other daily activities and outings as much as they wish.



## Mary's Place Fee

Prices effective October 2009. Fee schedules are subject to change as deemed necessary by the Mennonite Village Board of Directors.

\$4900 per month covers room and board, including:

- Breakfast, lunch, dinner, and snacks
- Social activities and outings
- Personal care items, such as soap, shampoo, etc.
- Basic bedroom furniture (optional)

The monthly fee does not cover the cost of personal undergarments or medications.

Children are welcome for visits during the day.

At this time, no pets will reside at Mary's Place, however, pets are welcome to visit, provided they are friendly and up-to-date on vaccines.

Mary's Place is a tobacco-free facility.
