A Life-Enriching Culture

Mennonite Village chaplains seek to supplement and support the ministry of local churches and ministers, and to encourage the spiritual life of each resident regardless of his or her religious affiliation or beliefs. Good Shepherd volunteers are trained and supervised by our chaplains and are also available for visits with our residents.

Weekly services of Christian ecumenical worship are led by the chaplains (Mennonite ministers) and feature preachers and musicians from a variety of denominational traditions. Residents from all neighborhoods within the Village are invited to attend services.

Chaplain Teresa Moser is an ordained Mennonite minister who was pastor of Sunrise Mennonite Church, Portland, Oregon, before coming to Mennonite Village. She earned a Master of Divinity from Eastern Mennonite Seminary in Harrisonburg, Virginia.

Chaplain Eric Martin joined the staff in the fall of 2008. He has over 25 years of experience in Christian education as teacher and administrator and holds a Master of Arts degree in Spiritual Formation from George Fox Evangelical Seminary. He primarily serves residents and staff of Quail Run Assisted Living and shares support for residents in the Village community through pastoral visits, Bible studies, Sunday worship, and staff enrichment.
