## A Comfortable Home

Mennonite Village began as a 24-room nursing home in 1947, operating under the name Mennonite Home for the Aged. From the beginning, this home was envisioned as a place where elders could live comfortably and receive peaceful, loving care as they grew older. That vision is in place today as we grow and continually expand our services.

Today, we offer an accredited continuing care retirement community for seniors that is alive with activity, light, and nature.

**Independent Living Homes** in Mennonite Village are designed for adults who currently enjoy an active lifestyle. The Village offers both freedom and security in a beautiful, park-like setting with spacious homes, health care options, and ample opportunities for social, recreational, and cultural fulfillment. Homes are available by Life Lease or a monthly rental lease.



## A Life-Enriching Culture

**In-Home Care** provides life-enriching services to residents of all faiths throughout Linn, Benton, and southern Marion counties, so they may live comfortably at home for as long as possible. Our service offering includes caregiver, C.N.A., and R.N. services, companions, homemakers, medication management, and Alzheimer's and hospice support.



**Independent Living Apartments** in Ashwood Courts I and II at Mennonite Village combine active living with dining and housekeeping services. Residents choose from studios or one- or two-bedroom apartments. Monthly rent includes daily lunch and dinner in a central dining room, weekly housekeeping, free bus service, and utilities.

**Assisted Living** at Quail Run is designed to accommodate the changing needs of its residents. Private studio and one-bedroom apartments come with three meals served in the central dining room, weekly housekeeping, bus service, and a variety of activities and personalized services to help each resident live a happy, rich life among friends.

## A Continuum of Care

**Alzheimer's and Dementia Care** at Lydia's House and Mary's Place was created and designed for those with Alzheimer's disease and related dementia as a natural extension of our Continuing Care Retirement Community. Specially trained staff give residents a safe, nurturing home where they feel accepted and their physical, social, emotional, and spiritual needs are met day and night.

**Nursing and Rehabilitation** services are provided at Mennonite Home, including 24-hour, short-term and long-term nursing care, inpatient and outpatient rehabilitation services, end of life care, and ongoing, 24-hour care for residents who are unable to live in a more independent setting.

Mennonite Village maintains contracts with Medicare and Medicaid for advanced health care services. Mennonite Village works with nearly all insurance carriers.
