Life-Enriching Memory Care

Loving and caring for a person with memory loss means adapting to ongoing change. For those with Alzheimer's disease and related dementia, each day can be filled with unfamiliar routines and people. Mennonite Village offers a solution in residential care at Lydia's House.

Lydia's House was created as a natural extension of Mennonite Village's continuum of care for people with mid-stage or advanced memory loss. Lydia's House provides a safe, nurturing home where residents are accepted and their physical, social, emotional, and spiritual needs are met both day and night.

Each of two "households" within Lydia's House has ten private bedrooms and two semi-private rooms, a large living room, kitchen, dining area, whirlpool bath, and laundry facilities.

An outdoor courtyard connects both households and provides residents added space for summer parties, concerts, and family gatherings. A paved path through the courtyard encourages walking, gardening, and other outdoor activities and exercise.

A structured yet flexible calendar meets residents' spiritual, social, and recreational interests. Activities are made available around the clock. Residents can choose to participate in household tasks, such as folding laundry and setting the dinner table, which add to the feeling of still being at home, as does "Cooper," the friendly pet dog.

Lydia's House employees are committed to their workplace and develop endearing relationships with residents and their families. Residents benefit from this stability and the familiarity of their caregivers. Some staff members have worked at Lydia's House since it opened in 1998!

Three Lydia's House caregivers have had their weddings in the courtyard at Lydia's House so "all of their family could be present."

Lydia's House employees receive special training to provide the unique type of care they deliver. A full-time nurse ensures each resident's medical needs are addressed. Caregivers assist residents with personal care needs and also prepare and serve meals and perform other light housekeeping and laundry duties.

Lydia's House Fees

Prices effective October 1, 2016. Fee schedules are subject to change as deemed necessary by the Mennonite Village Board of Directors.

There is no application fee.
